

Copyright policy

- The work in question is protected by copyright and/or any other applicable law. Any use of the work other than authorised under this license or copyright law is strictly prohibited.
- Copyright of any paper in *nb!ict* is retained by the author(s).
- Author(s) grant *nb!ict* the license to publish the paper in the journal and on the *nb!ict* website, and identify itself as the original publisher.
- Author(s) sign a *nb!ict* license to publish when submitting their paper for publication.
- By signing this license, authors hereby agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of the license.
- This license may not be altered in any way, unless done so in agreement with licensor.

***nb!ict* license to publish**

1. In agreeing to publish the paper in *nb!ict*, the author(s) grant *nb!ict* the exclusive license (a) to publish, reproduce, distribute, display and store the paper in all forms, formats and media, (b) to create adaptations, summaries or extracts of the paper, and (c) to make such editorial changes as may be necessary to make the paper suitable for publication.
2. By publishing their paper in *nb!ict*, the author(s) also grant the right to publish the paper on the *nb!ict* website, and they grant any third party the right to use the paper freely as long as its integrity is maintained and its original authors, citation details and publisher are identified. The *nb!ict* copyright license (identical to the Creative Commons Attribution License) formalises these as well as other terms and conditions of publishing research papers.
3. Ownership of copyright remains with the author(s). They retain the rights to reproduce the paper in whole or in part after it has been published in *nb!ict*, provided that, when reproducing the paper or extracts from it, the author(s) acknowledge its prior publication in *nb!ict*. Likewise, a copy of the paper may be posted on the World Wide Web, provided there is a hyperlink from the paper to the *nb!ict* website www.nbict.net.
4. The authors are in no way permitted to sign copyright agreements with other publishers that will regard the original publication in *nb!ict* as illegal.
5. By signing this agreement, the author(s) warrant, that:
 - a) The paper is original, it has not formally been published in any other peer-reviewed journal, and it is not under consideration by any other journal. An earlier version of the paper may have been published as a ‘grey publication’ (e.g. working paper) prior to its publishing in *nb!ict*;
 - b) They are the sole authors and sole owners of the copyright in the paper. If the paper includes materials of others, the author(s) have secured the necessary written permissions from the appropriate copyright owner(s) or authorities for the reproduction in the paper and *nb!ict* of any text, illustration, or other material;

- c) The paper contains no statement that is abusive, defamatory, libellous, slanderous, obscene, fraudulent, nor in any way infringes the rights of others, nor is in any other way unlawful or in violation of applicable laws (including without limitation copyright, patent or trademark laws);
 - d) All of the facts contained in the paper are true and accurate.
6. If the paper is prepared jointly with other authors, the author who has signed this agreement warrants that s/he has been authorised by all co-authors to sign this agreement on their behalf, and to agree on their behalf the order of names in the publication of the paper.
